NBFSMN Data Distribution

Background:

The data from the Narragansett Bay Fixed Site Monitoring Network (NBFSMN) utilized by this website is a subset of the data found on <u>http://www.dem.ri.gov/programs/emergencyresponse/bart/netdata.php</u>). The program description, data distribution information, disclaimers, citation information, and NBFSMN official websites can be found below.

Narragansett Bay Fixed Site Monitoring Network (NBFSMN) is a multi-agencies effort to establish a network of physical water quality monitoring in Narragansett Bay. The network is now an essential component of Rhode Island's monitoring strategy for the Bay. The stations were located strategically to transect the length of Narragansett Bay and serve as sentinels of changing conditions. There is a greater concentration of sites in upper Narragansett Bay purposefully located due to the presence of discharges from both wastewater treatment facilities and large tributary rivers. The DEM Office of Water Resources has taken a lead role in coordinating the multi-agency network effort. The cooperating agencies are as follows:

Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management- Office of Water Resources (RIDEM-OWR), University of Rhode Island, Graduate School of Oceanography (URI-GSO), Narragansett Bay Commission (NBC), Narragansett Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve (NBNERR), Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MADEP)

For distribution of NBFSMN data and metadata: The NBFSMN officially distributes the data through the RIDEM website.

Narragansett Bay Fixed Site Monitoring Network (NBFSMN) and it site principal investigators (PIs) retains the right to analyze, synthesize and publish summaries of the NBFSMN data. The Principal Investigator and NBFSMN retains the right to be fully credited for having collected and processed the data. Manuscripts resulting from using the NBNERR operated stations data (T-Wharf) requires an additional acknowledgement of: Manuscripts resulting from this NOAA/OCM-supported research and data collection effort that are produced for publication in open literature, including refereed scientific journals, shall acknowledge that the research was conducted under an award from the Estuarine Reserves Division, Office for Coastal Management, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.
